



Center Skating Academy Code of Conduct

- All parents and skaters must retain a positive attitude and encourage sportsmanship by showing respect and courtesy, and by demonstrating positive support for all skaters and coaches, will encourage fellow skaters and will not engage in negative practices whether verbal or physical, toward fellow skaters, parents, or coaches during all CSA events.
- Parents will inform coaches of any physical disability or ailment that may affect the safety of their child or the safety of others.
- Parents, skaters, and coaches will treat each other with the spirit of sportsmanship and will resolve conflicts without resorting to hostility or violence.
- All coaches must have current USFS, ISI, or USA Hockey coaching credentials on file with the Club President. All coaches must be SafeSport Certified.
- Skaters and Coaches must be aware of and respectful of patterns of other skaters and coaches on sessions.
- Skaters and Coaches will abide by the Freestyle Ice Rules linked on the CSA website.
- Give way to figure skaters performing their programs
- Hockey sticks and pucks are not allowed on Freestyle Ice sessions
- Coaches must stay as close to the boards as possible and keep your sight on traffic. Semi Private lessons should skate their patterns single file.
- All coaches will have a designated place from which to instruct, keeping 6 foot diameter.
- All skaters must check in at the front desk before taking the ice. All sessions must be paid prior to taking the ice. Venmo, check, or cash is accepted. We don't have the ability to make change for large bills, so please plan ahead. Exact change is preferred.
